



GENERAL INFORMATION

VENUE:

The Academy will be held at the conference halls of the hotel "Baltic Beach Hotel & SPA *****", Jurmala Resort, Riga, Latvia, September 2010 from 3rd to 6th. The September 2nd is Arrival day. The September 6th is Departure day.

LANGUAGES: The official language is English (simultaneous translation English-Latvian-English and English-Russian-English will be present).

REGISTRATION:

The special offer for general registration fee in the Academy for participants from Baltic countries is 85 € (for all days of the Academy) and including materials, conference service, coffee and lunch. The special conditions for one day registration fee are available as 25 € (1st day), 30 € (3rd day) and 45 € (3rd and 4th Summit days). Special offer for CME course only is 20 €. The number of delegates from one country is not limited on the CME and other days of the Academy. The deadline for registration at reduced fee is June 30th 2010. Previous registration must be done on the website of the Academy www.reena.org.ua no later June 30th. Delegates from Latvia can make direct payments in LVL on the bank account of the official territorial partner in Latvia (VAT is over). Registration on spot will be possible but will not guarantee full free of charge conference-services of the Academy. Entrance management control of conference halls will be present during all days of the Academy.

MATERIALS: The folder of participant included into registration fee is consisted with personal cards, program, materials on CD, certificate of the Academy. Certificates and materials of CME course are given free of charge. Other materials will be given for an additional pay on the registration desk during the days of the Academy.
